Kindergarten/First Grade Registration

Registration for kindergarten and first grade in Greenville County Schools will be held Monday – Thursday, January 11-14, 2015. Children who will be five years old on or before September 1, 2016 must enroll in public or private kindergarten, unless the parent or legal guardian signs a waiver. Any child who will be six years old on or before September 1, 2016 must enroll in first grade. Visit your Greenville County public school January 11-14 to register.
